Tuition Policies

School Age Child Care Tuition Policy

Our program is designed with a start and end date to cover the whole session. Your registration is for the entire school year program. This is not a weekly drop-in program. The weekly rate advertised is informational so families can budget accordingly.

There are no breaks in payments due to closure. We calculate the schedule and spread the charges across each session evenly including all closures and holidays. We do this in order to make the payments the same throughout the program.

Vacation Camp Cancellation Policy

If you wish to cancel or change your child's enrollment, you must submit your request in writing a minimum of 5 business days in advance of the date your child is registered. If the request to cancel or change enrollment is less than 5 business days in advance, monies paid will be forfeited and no refund or credit will be issued.

Before Care Drop Off

- Bolden, Tuscan, Marshall, South Mountain: Entrance by cafeteria doors
- Montrose: Back of the school gym entrance
- Seth Boyden: On the Loop to the door next to the auditorium until 8:15 am, afterwards back of the school through the cafeteria
- Please don't park in the parking lot of the schools as teachers are reporting to the schools at the same time as our programs.

General SACC After Care Info

After Care Pick Up

- School based sites will be at the cafeteria doors
- Montrose: Gym Door in the back of the school
- Program Center: The far right glass door as you enter the parking lot at 13 Jefferson Ave
- St. Joe's: The center doors of the building as you face the school at 240 Franklin Ave.
- Alternate Pick Up's and parents may be required to bring ID until we get to know you.

Dismissal From School to the Program

Please see the reporting location for your child when dismissed from their class to go to After Care. All children at an off site location should report to the same locations below.

Clinton: Cafeteria Montrose: Gym

Marshall: Cafeteria South Mountain (2nd-5th): Auditorium

Bolden: Cafeteria Annex: Gym

Tuscan: Cafeteria Seth Boyden: Cafeteria

The Y staff will have separate spaces in the reporting spaces for bus children to go to the off site location.

Medical Needs

If your child requires the YMCA to provide daily or emergency medications:

- 1. Submit a Permission to Medicate Form to the site supervisor (this can be emailed to you by myself or an Assistant Director).
- 2. The medication must be in the original container and have:
 - a. Child's Name
 - b. Dosage
 - c. Doctor's Name
 - d. Care Plan from the Doctor for Administration
- 3. Each medication need it's own form.
- 4. Be mindful of the expiration date for the medication.
