TODDLERS

2 - 3 years

2yrs by 10/1 through 3yrs by 9/30

Full/Part-week

Toddlers experience significant advancements in self help skills, identifying emotions, taking turns, language and fine motor skills. Staff meet children where they are while helping build their confidence and social skills.
